Animates school holiday programme

School holidays are just around the corner and, for the first time, Animates is partnering with 'Kids Safe with Dogs' to provide the perfect activity to help educate children how to behave around dogs.

Your local Animates store will be hosting free seminars at 11am on Thursday 5 and 12 October. Trained staff will use interactive real life scenarios (using a toy dog) to teach children how to behave around their own dog and those that they encounter on the street.

Key points will include:
